in 2020, there was a roof evaluation done by Crown Roofing, and we followed up by having all of the non-vent/dent related issues repaired for \$14,165

in 2022, we spent \$2,200 with Singleton Roofing to have Hurricane Ian roof repair issues fixed. Half of that was charged to reserves

in 2023, the \$7,369 repair expense was for Piper invoices for upgrades to buildings 5-12, splitting the system up and converting to cell dialers
